ATR VERDICT: Dark Vision appears to have turned a corner in two starts this season having become a frustrating individual to follow last season. Mark Johnston's colt built on a solid comeback when second at Newcastle to land the Royal Hunt Cup at Royal Ascot but, at the weights on this occasion, there is every chance the runner-up from that contest, MONTATHAM, could reverse the form. William Haggas' grey did best of those drawn low and appears to have further improvement to come, especially if held on to a bit longer. Mutasaamy left behind a poor effort at Newcastle to score in great style at Kempton and he is respected along with Acquitted, who clearly wasn't right at Royal Ascot after finishing second to St James's Palace winner Palace Pier at Newcastle, and Zwayyan.

ATR VERDICT: The Duke Of Edinburgh Stakes first and second, SCARLET DRAGON and Deja, lock horns once again and, despite a 7lb rise, Alan King's charge is backed to again come out on top. The seven-year-old was still full of running at the finish on that occasion and the booking of Cieren Fallon reduces his weight burden by a handy 3lb. Deja is a consistent performer and is sure to be thereabouts, while Le Don De Vie and Indianapolis, fourth and fifth in the aforementioned Ascot contest, come into calculations too on revised terms. The latter of that pair was fourth in this last season, while Mark Johnston looks to enhance his fine record in the race with The Trader, Hochfeld and possibly Star Of The East (the latter of whom is a reserve). Laafy impressed at Newbury and is another to consider, likewise recent course winner Babbo's Boy.

ATR VERDICT: Enable was denied a third victory in the Arc de Triomphe by Waldgeist when suffering her first defeat since April 2017 and all roads lead back to the first weekend in October for another crack at history. She won this contest 12 months ago but this appears to be a stronger renewal and recent Coronation Cup hero GHAIYYATH could make life tough for John Gosden's star mare. The son of Dubawi was disappointing in the Arc himself, when probably feeling the effects of a devastating victory in Group 1 company at Baden-Baden the month before, but he has been in terrific form this campaign with a bloodless success in the Dubai Millennium at Meydan, when preparing for the Sheema Classic, followed by an excellent display at Newmarket last month. Japan is likely to come forward from his return in the Prince Of Wales's at Royal Ascot in a similar manner to how he progressed from each start last season, while the Japanese mare Deirdre cannot be discounted.

ATR VERDICT: SILVERTOWN was well-backed on his handicap debut at Tipperary and duly obliged with a cosy success. Neither a 9lbs hike in the ratings (partly offset by his rider's claim) nor an extra furlong should prevent him from following up. Connections would presumably like to see an ease in the ground having taken out the Make Believe gelding a couple of times when the ground was described as good. Charlie Bassett ran respectably in probably the best maiden of the season behind Irish Derby runner-up Tiger Moth at Leopardstown. He finished in front of Wednesday's runaway winner Red Kelly on that occasion, and is respected on his own handicap bow. Comfort Line had little chance against the well-treated Protagonist the last twice but may find it hard again at level weights with the selection, while The Truant ran respectably behind the progressive Moll at Leopardstown.
